I have the following to report for the month of March:

Emergency Calls:

- EMS: 20
- FIRE: 7
- MVC: 2
- Mutual Aide: 0
- Public Service: 0

Total: 29 Calls

Emergency Call Response:

Part Time: 13 Emergency calls were handled by our part-time personnel.

Volunteer: 16 Emergency calls were handled by our volunteer personnel.

Training:

We have completed our department Haz-Mat Awareness training. Additional Haz-Mat training will continue throughout the year until the Department's needs are met.

Grants:

The FEMA Grant has now opened. We have begun the application process and I will keep you posted on any updates.

Misc:

I have spoken with the Village of Holland's administrator regarding the fire gear purchase. They have requested to meet prior to the subject being brought forward to council. I will keep you posted on the progress.

We have received our Haz-Mat supplies. The supplies were distributed to all Three Engine's in kits and inventoried. These supplies, on hazardous materials incidents, will be able to be restocked through Lucas County by the person or company responsible for the spill.
